21 **TO DEFENDANTS AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:**

22 Plaintiff COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE's Ex Parte Application came on for ex parte hearing on April
23 9, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. in Department 32 before the Honorable John Vineyard, presiding in the above-
24 entitled court, located at 4100 Main Street, Riverside, California 92501.

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2 **TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

3 To Defendants Grace Baptist Church and Tim Shanks:

4 Based upon the County of Riverside's ("County") Ex Parte Application, Memorandum of Points
5 and Authorities in support thereof, Declaration of Kelly Moran, any and all written materials submitted in
6 support thereof, the arguments of all counsel and parties at the hearing on the matter, and good cause
7 appearing herein, the court grants the County's request for a Temporary Restraining Order against
8 Defendants. This Court finds that there is immediate threat to public health and safety based upon the
9 violation of *Health and Safety Code* sections 101030, 101040, 101085, AND 120175; Title 17 California
10 Code of Regulations section 2501; Article XI of the California Constitution; *Government Code* sections
11 8610, 8630, 8634, 8558 and 8655; and Riverside County Ordinances 442 and 533.6., along with the Orders
12 Against Public Gatherings cited in the moving papers, at 2781 S Lincoln Ave, Corona, CA 92882 known
13 as Grace Baptist Church.

14 **THE FOLLOWING IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

15 Defendants, and all of their respective owners, agents, employees, representatives, members,
16 volunteers, and all persons acting for or in concert with them, and their assignees and successors, are hereby
17 forthwith enjoined and prohibited and ordered to immediately cease and desist any gatherings of the Grace
18 Baptist Church congregation for in-person services at the property known as Grace Baptist Church located
19 at 2781 S Lincoln Ave, Corona, CA 92882.

20 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the County and its personnel, including employees of the
21 Sheriff's Department, City Police Departments, Code Enforcement Departments, Department of Public
22 Health, the Fire Department and other applicable governmental agencies are hereby authorized to: enter
23 onto the property at 2781 S Lincoln Ave, Corona, CA 92882, to post notice of this Order in visible locations
24 on said Property, including, but limited to, on exterior fences, gates, structures, doors or any other structure
25 thereupon and to distribute this Order to Defendants and/or any other persons present on the Property.

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2 **ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

3 To Defendants Grace Baptist Church and Tim Shanks:

4 Based upon the County of Riverside's ("County") Ex Parte Application, Memorandum of Points
5 and Authorities in support thereof, Declaration of Kelly Moran, any and all written materials submitted in
6 support thereof, the arguments of all counsel and parties at the hearing on the matter, and good cause
7 appearing herein, Defendants are ordered to appear on 4/29/2020 at 9:00 a.m. in
8 Riverside County Superior Court located at 4100 Main Street, Riverside, California 92501 in Department
9 32 via telephone, to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be ordered prohibiting, restraining,
10 and enjoining Defendants, and all of their respective agents, officers, employees, representatives, members,
11 volunteers, and all persons acting for or in concert with them, and their assignees and successors, from
12 gathering at 2781 S Lincoln Ave, Corona, CA 92882, commonly known as Grace Baptist Church, for in-
13 person church services during the COVID-19 pandemic based upon the violation of *Health and Safety Code*
14 sections 101030, 101040, 101085, AND 120175; Title 17 California Code of Regulations section 2501;
15 Article XI of the California Constitution; *Government Code* sections 8610, 8630, 8634, 8558 and 8655; and
16 Riverside County Ordinances 442 and 533.6., along with the Orders Against Public Gatherings.

17 Defendants are also ordered to show cause why the Court should not order all the below provisions
18 of the temporary restraining order remain in effect as part of the preliminary injunction order:

19 That the County and its personnel, including employees of the Sheriff's Department, City Police
20 Departments, Code Enforcement Departments, Department of Public Health, the Fire Department and other
21 applicable governmental agencies are hereby authorized to: enter onto the property at 2781 S Lincoln Ave,
22 Corona, CA 92882, to post notice of this Order in visible locations on said Property, including, but limited
23 to, on exterior fences, gates, structures, doors or any other structure thereupon and to distribute this Order
24 to Defendants and/or any other persons present on the Property.
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1 This Order to Show Cause and Temporary Restraining Order shall be served on Defendants no
2 later than 4/10/2020 by personal service, overnight courier, facsimile, or electronic
3 mail. No later than 5:00 pm.

4 Proof of service shall be filed no later than OSC Hearing.

5 Any Opposition papers to the Order to Show Cause shall be filed and served on Plaintiff by
6 personal service, overnight courier, facsimile, or electronic mail no later than

7 4/23/2020.

8 Any Reply papers to the Order to Show Cause shall be filed and served on Defendants by personal
9 service, overnight courier, facsimile, or electronic mail no later than 4/27/2020.

10 The Temporary Restraining Order granted herein shall expire on 4/29/2020.
